



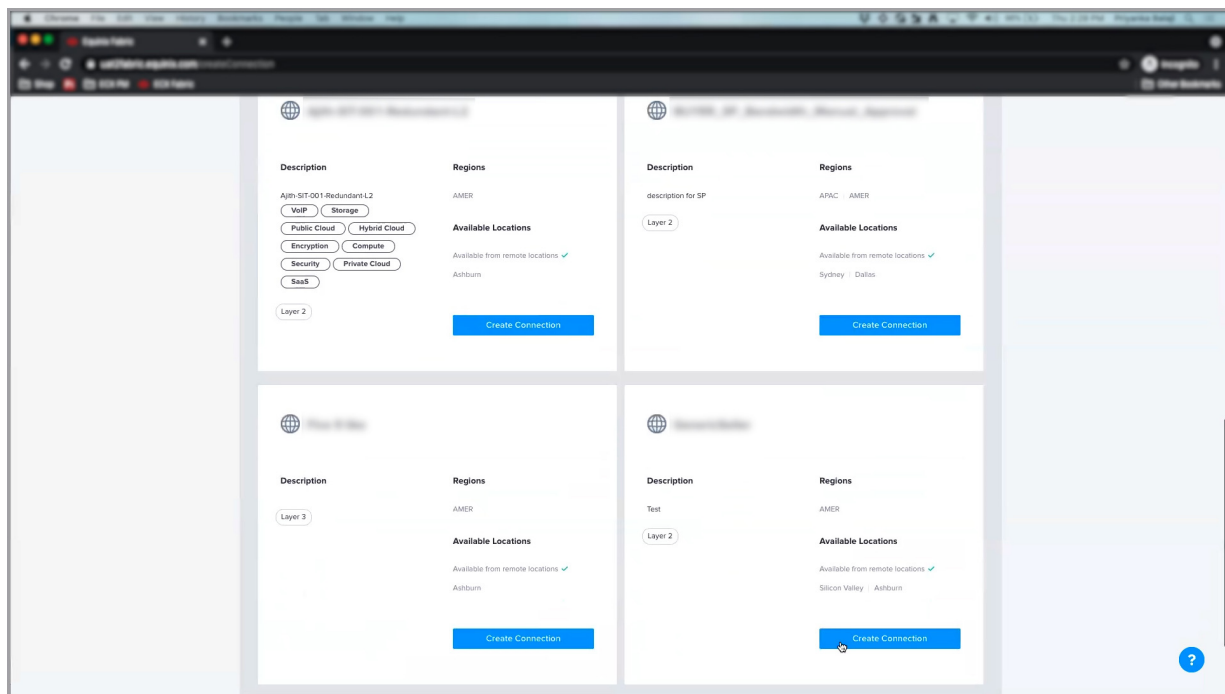

# Create a Connection with an A-side Token

Equinix Fabric 2021.2

Hi, I'm **Priyanka Balaji** and I'm a Senior Associate Product Manager at Equinix. In this video, I'm going to show you how to redeem an A-side Service Token and create a Virtual Connection to any available destination on Equinix Fabric. Please note that the destination can be one of the 200+ service providers available on Fabric or another Equinix Fabric customer. Additional steps may be required depending on who you are creating a connection to. I'm logged into the Equinix Fabric Portal as a user and here is the Create Connection landing page. Select the Service Provider or the Equinix Fabric customer you wish to connect to and Click on Create Connection.

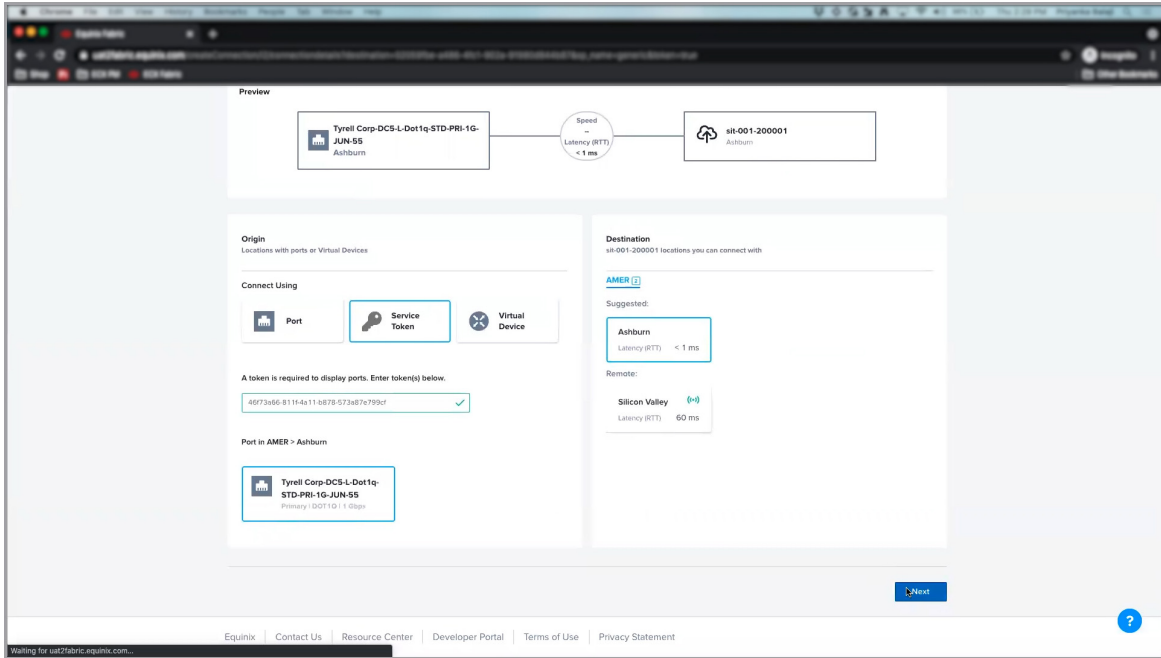

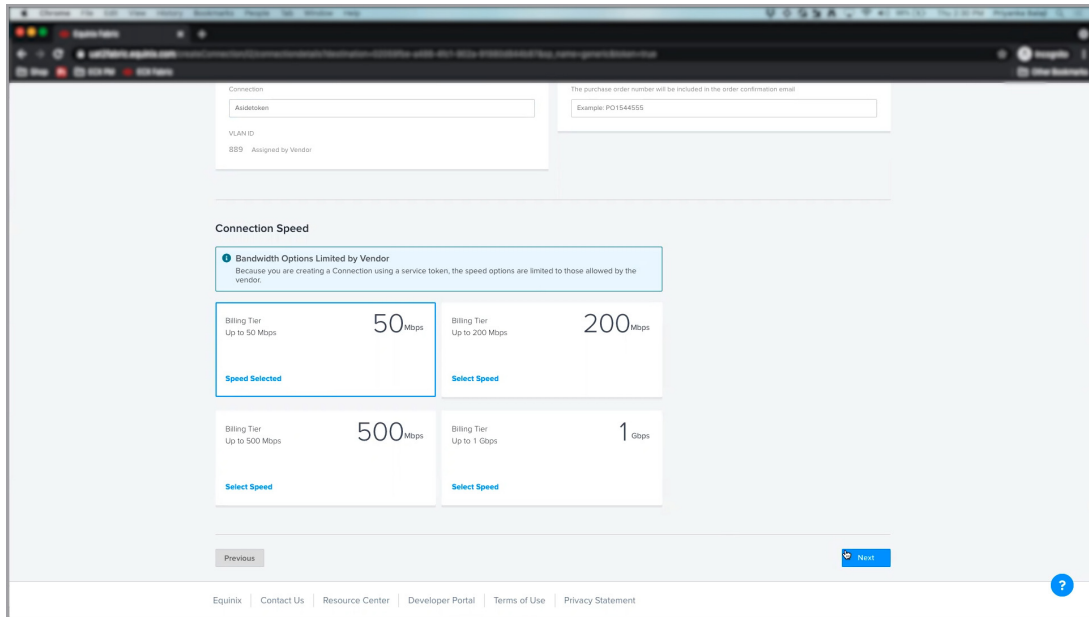
## CREATE A CONNECTION WITH AN A-SIDE TOKEN

The first step involves selecting origin and destination locations for the virtual connection. Click on the Connect Using Service Token option and enter the service token given by your provider. As you can see, this token is then validated, and the port assigned to you is displayed at the bottom of the Origin tile. On the right-hand side, select the destination location you would like to connect with and Click on Next.

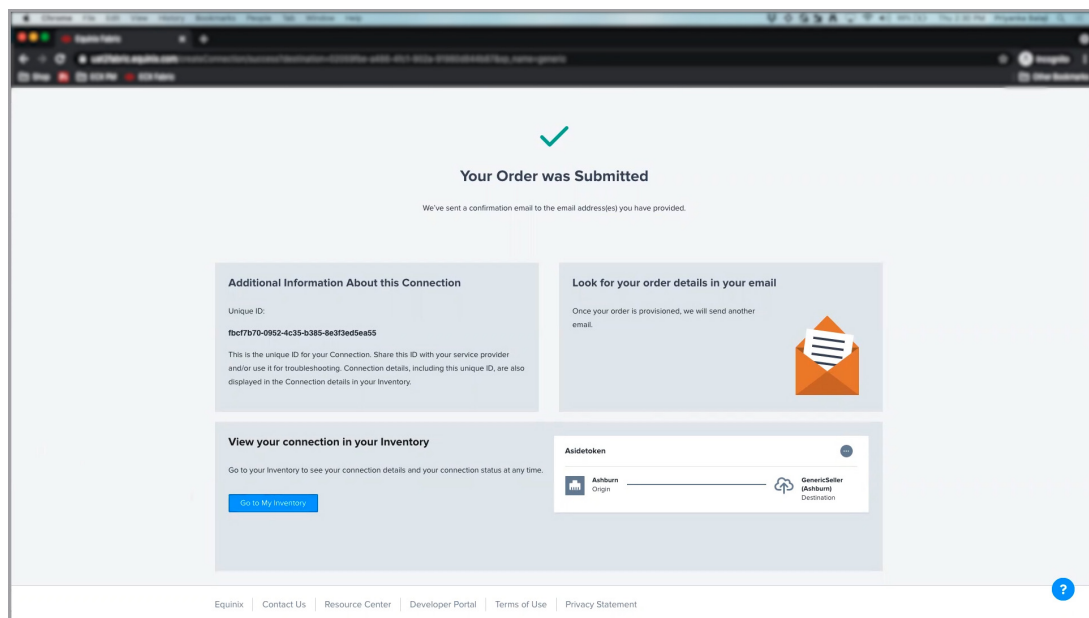


In the Connection Details page, the Preview section offers an overview of the Connection Topology with the origin and destination locations, connection speed and Latency. Enter a name for the connection and select the required connection speed option. The VLAN ID is pre-defined in the service token provided by the vendor. As you can see in the note here, the connection speed option is limited to those pre-defined and allowed by the vendor. Please note that this connection will be billed to the vendor who has created the A-side service token. Please note that the connections details section may request for additional information depending on the destination you are connecting to. Click Next to navigate to the final step.

# CREATE A CONNECTION WITH AN A-SIDE TOKEN



The review page provides a preview of the connection details, connection summary and notification contacts. Please note that you can add or modify the email addresses that should be notified about this connection under the Notifications section. Click on Submit Order. You have now successfully created a virtual connection using an A-side Service Token. The confirmation page includes additional information on this connection, including the Unique ID and a link to view the connection in your inventory.
