### Network Edge 2021.4

This release includes the addition of Cisco Catalyst 8000V Edge, improvements to Azure ExpressRoute connection capabilities, the ability to use Panorama™ to manage Palo Alto device clusters, and a new device Reload feature. Network Edge 2021.4 also includes new ACL template and device inventory search capabilities.
