Network Edge 2022.2

This release includes a new customer trial experience, a memory upgrade option for Palo Alto Network virtual devices, the introduction of single BYOC untagged connections, and Access Control List (ACL) workflow optimization.

New Customer Trial Experience

Test drive Network Edge capabilities across all metros, for any vendor in the marketplace, with a free trial. At the end of the trial, convert to a production account without losing any trial devices.

Memory Upgrade for Palo Alto Networks Devices

Upgrade your existing PANW devices to stay on top of the latest security releases. The workflow supports upgrading the devices to the required memory and version update, providing the necessary fix to the latest critical patch from PANW.

Single BYOC Untagged Connection

Connect to a Network Service Provider (NSP) that is not on Equinix Fabric with new functionality allowing you to create an untagged connection between the NSP and a Network Edge device.

ACL Workflow Optimization

You are now required to select an Access Control List (ACL) template during the virtual device creation workflow, streamlining day one operations.
